

PROJECT 37 POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

1. Entry Requirements

Minimum Age: 18 years. ID Check: A valid ID must be presented upon request. Bag Checks: For safety reasons, staff may search you and your (hand) bags.

2. Zero-Tolerance Policy

Project 37 strictly prohibits discrimination, including - but not limited to - xenophobia, homophobia, transphobia, racism, sexism, colorism, ageism, or hate of any form, harassment, whether sexual, verbal, emotional, or physical and in general violent behavior. Clothing with discriminatory, group-specific, or offensive text or imagery is not allowed. Any activity of this nature will result in immediate removal from the event and potential exclusion from future events.

3. Entry and Refunds

Project 37 holds the right, at all times, to deny entry to anyone, whether in possession of a presale ticket or not. Reasons for denied entry may include – but are not limited to – a visible state of intoxication, a disrespectful and/or violent attitude towards any of our staff, or attempting entry to the event in informal or inappropriate/offensive attire.

4. During the Event

During the event, the doors will close at a specified time. Make sure to enter the event area before this time. Access after the specified time may be denied. Your attendance will be marked with a wrist stamp, allowing re-entry to the same event. Project 37 has the right to refuse access to people who violate the rules and/or disrupt the event.

5. Safety and Security

Safety for our visitors is the top priority. Security and first aid are present. In addition, the P37 staff is always there for you. It is important to take care of each other. Check-in regularly to make sure everyone feels safe and comfortable. Any violent or threatening behavior will not be tolerated and will result in immediate removal from the event area and potential exclusion from future events.

7. Substances and Alcohol

Illegal substances are strictly prohibited. Bringing your own food and drinks is not allowed.

8. Photography and Recordings

By attending, you agree to be photographed or filmed by Project 37, promoters, or media partners. It is prohibited to bring or use professional photo-, film-, drone-, sound-and/or other recording equipment without written permission. We use stickers to cover your flashlight. Please be considerate about this and do not remove them.

9. Promotional Material

You are part of a Project 37 event; please do not share any promotional material (samples/flyers, etc.) without written permission.
